

## Go for UOWCHK full-time degrees or sub-degrees in 2024/25 and enjoy HK\$10,000 Entrance Scholarship and Guaranteed Overseas Study Tour to UOW campuses in Australia/Malaysia

## **UOWCHK Entrance Scholarships 2024/25 (For current 2024 HKDSE candidates)**

The **UOWCHK Entrance Scholarships** aim to award newly admitted full-time students who have attained satisfactory results in Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSE) in 2024.

Current 2024 HKDSE candidates who have fulfilled the following requirements will be awarded the entrance scholarships and no prior application is required.

- 1. The value of each award shall be **HK\$10,000**. The scholarships will be disbursed to awardees in <u>two</u> <u>equal instalments</u> (HK\$5,000 per instalment), upon satisfactory completion of at least 5 courses in Semester A 2024/25 and Semester A 2025/26.
- 2. To be eligible for the scholarships, applicants should:
  - be permanent residents of the HKSAR;
  - be current 2024 HKDSE candidates and have satisfied the minimum entrance requirements for entering into UOWCHK sub-degree or bachelor degree programmes (combined certificates are **NOT** considered); and
  - be enrolled in **full-time** UOWCHK sub-degree programmes (associate degree/higher diploma) or bachelor degree programmes.

## **HKDSE** Requirements

- **Sub-degree** applicants: having scored <u>16 points</u> or above in 5 HKDSE subjects, including "Level 2" or above in English Language and Chinese Language.
- Degree applicants: having scored <u>18 points</u> or above in 5 HKDSE subjects; including "Level 3" or above in English Language and Chinese Language, "Level 2" or above in Mathematics (Compulsory Part) and "Attained" in Citizenship and Social Development.

\*Grade Point Conversion: Level 5\*\*=7, Level 5\*=6, Level 5=5, Level 4=4, Level 3=3, Level 2/Attained=2, Level 1=1 and Unclassified = 0.

## **Overseas Study Tour**

UOWCHK places heavy emphasis on providing students with an enriching learning experience during their studies in the College. To widen students' horizons, the College organizes overseas study tours for students to visit other campuses of the UOW Global Network. Below are the eligibility requirements for the Overseas Study Tours:

- Applicants should be permanent residents of the HKSAR;
- The programme fee and accommodation costs will be borne by UOWCHK. Students are only required to pay for the round-trip air ticket and personal expenses;
- Applicants should have enrolled in a full-time UOWCHK programme to study for a sub-degree/bachelor degree (awarded by the College) and have completed the first year of their studies:
  - Sub-degree students will visit UOW Malaysia.
  - Degree students will visit UOW Australia.
